Five College Students To Receive Scholarships From American Water Ski Educational Foundation

She is a member of the FSC Honors Program for achieving a high ACT score and overall excellence in academics. She is the captain of the Texas A&M ski team and an active participant in the American Water Ski Association as a competitor, assistant judge and scorer.

Caroline Hensley (Hixson, Tenn.) is awarded the Southern Region- Elmer Stailing Scholarship. She is a sophomore at the University of Alabama, majoring in chemical engineering. She is a member of the Alabama ski team and serves as treasurer.

The Jennifer Odom/David Kammerer Memorial Scholarship is awarded to **Andrew P. Martin (Huntington, Ind.)**. He has received this scholarship three times. He is a senior majoring in computer science and DMA-animation. He competes at the regional and national level in barefoot water skiing.
